CHAPLIN'S AGREEMENT

This Chaplin's Agreement, made this twentieth day

of October 1920, between Buster Chaplin (Party 1), Most Famous and

Talented Movie Star in the Entire World, of [REDACTED], [REDACTED],

[REDACTED], Los Angeles, and Glitzy von Tinsel (Party 2),

actress, of [REDACTED], [REDACTED], London

England, declareth:

- 1 (a) Party 2 is forbidden from discussing any part of The Chaplin's Agreement with anyone other than their lawyer, in a soundproofed room.
- 1 (b) Party 2 agrees to [REDACTED] and also [REDACTED] such as, but not limited to: [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] with Party 1 whenever he sees fit
- 1 (c) Party 2 agrees to [REDACTED] in the [REDACTED] at a moment's notice.

- 2 (a) This Chaplin's Agreement bounds Party 2 to make movies with Party 1 for ten years as of the date of this contract.
- 2 (b) Only in the event of an act of God such as a [REDACTED], a tornado or [REDACTED] [REDACTED] will temporarily halt this contract, or such an event that the movie footage should be lost, damaged, stolen or [REDACTED].
- 2 (c) In the event that [REDACTED]
